49ers and Cowboys in a thriller



The NFC Championship was played by two team that were know for their big play capabilities and depth of talent. The 49ers had seemed to live by the passing game which features all-pro WR, Joe Lachiusa, rookie sensation, Chris Bouie, and sure handed TE, John Gmitter. They appeared to have surprised the Cowboys when coming out primarily with the run. This seemed to be the perfect game plan, as the Cowboys are a fast defense that do a great deal of blitzing. Behind some great upfront blocking, RB Mike Wilson tore things up. It was Wilson's 48 yard blast that set up the 49ers first TD. QB, Tim McBride found Chris Bouie for the games first TD, on the 49ers second possession and the half's only TD. The Cowboys moved the ball on offense very well, particularly on throws to Mike Preisser and runs by Carl Fantauzzo. With time running down, Frank Selvaggio went deep, this time to Brian Schilling who made a great catch at the 3 yard line. Schilling was flagged at the one yard line by Lachiusa, and the Cowboys were unable to get another play off before time had expired in the first half. We saw great defensive plays by both teams as they desperately tried to prevent one another from making the big plays. Mike Paddock had a key sack to stop a 49ers drive. Doung Truong knocked down a 4th down pass to give the Cowboys the ball back. Chad Secor had his best game as a Cowboy defender, making several flags. Dan Ryan came up with several flag preventing runners from advancing the ball, as well as providing great coverage on the Cowboys receivers. John Leastman continued his cam-

paign for rookie defensive player of the year. Leastman's number was called over and over for making the stop. Lachiusa not only made the TD saving flag to end the half, but also add an interception and a forth down pass deflection. John Gmitter had a sack and forced several hurried throws. Jim LaRuez also knocked down a pass to end a drive. In the second half Leastman and Ryan continued to stand out but Selvaggio and Preisser were connecting almost at will. The Cowboys tied the game when Selvaggio hit Nelson Rivera on a fade pattern. The 49ers answered back by continuing to run Wilson, who set up yet another TD from McBride to Bouie. As time was quickly slipping away the Cowboys were not going to let this game go without great effort. On forth down and the game on the line, Selvaggio goes to the back of the end zone to Todd Petroske. Petroske made a great catch, but when extending for the ball his feet had left the ground and made the catch out of bounds. This game was a classic and left all of us exhausted from the excitement.

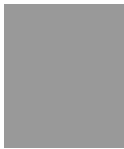

The Jets waited to the play-offs before they won their first game and the way they started this AFC Championship off made one think they were unstoppable. The Jets, Emmanuel Bradley intercepted a pass on the first drive and that set up the Jets first TD. QB Matt Savery found his WR Marlon Salmon for the games first points. Despite

some big yards on the ground from Raiders RB, Bill Fedele, Raiders could not score on their second possession. The Raider defense stepped up in a big way and quickly ended a Jet drive. On the next Raider possession, Bradley intercepted another pass and this time took it the distance for the Jets second TD of the day. Bradley also brought in the 2 point conversion and before anyone knew it the Jets had a 14 point lead. Fedele continued to pick up yards on their next drive, but it was Bradley with an interception once again to

Fedele scored, on a run, early in the second half and Logory found Kevin Nichols for the 2 point conversion to tie the game. Nichols went in again to break the game open for the Raiders. The Jets were unable to get anything going offensively until Savery hit Bradley a couple times down field, but their drive ended just under

2 minutes when Robert Oakden made a great play on forth down to flag Marlon Salmon before he made the first. The Raiders were able to pick up a first down on their possession which enabled them the run out the clock and seal the victory.
